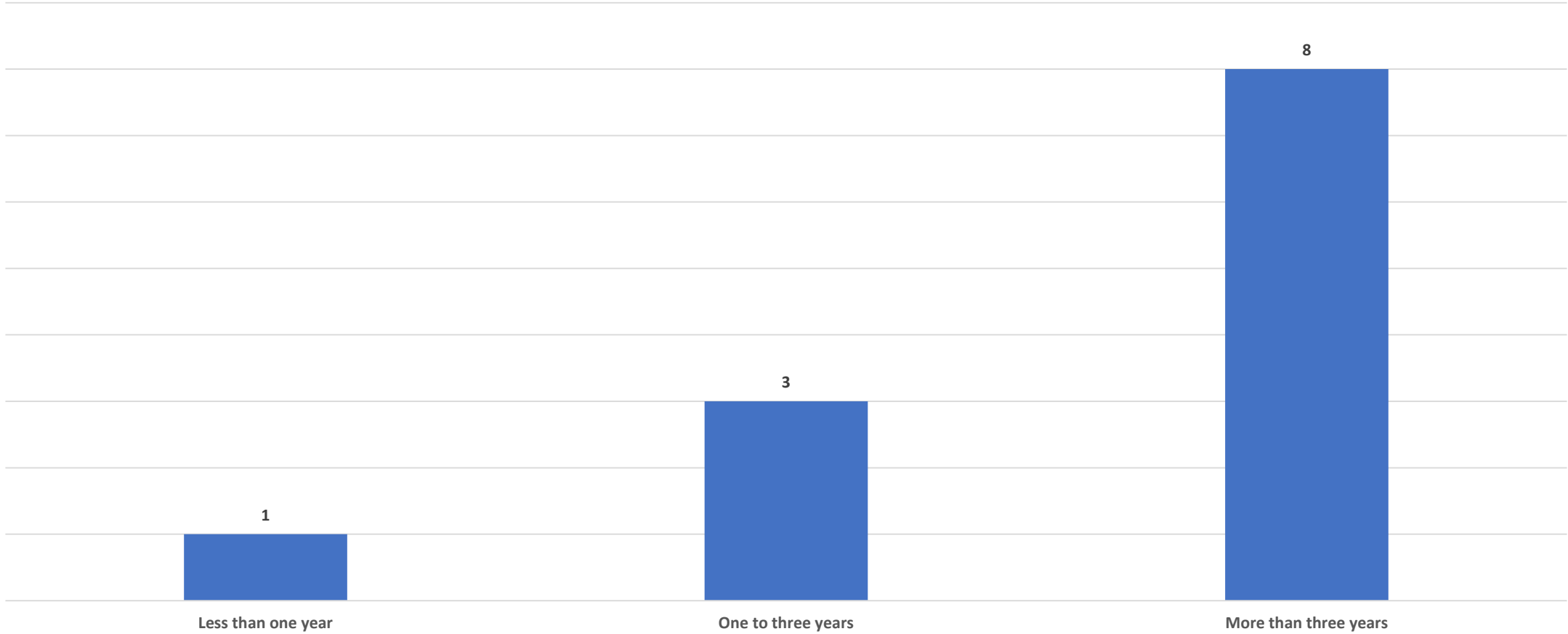
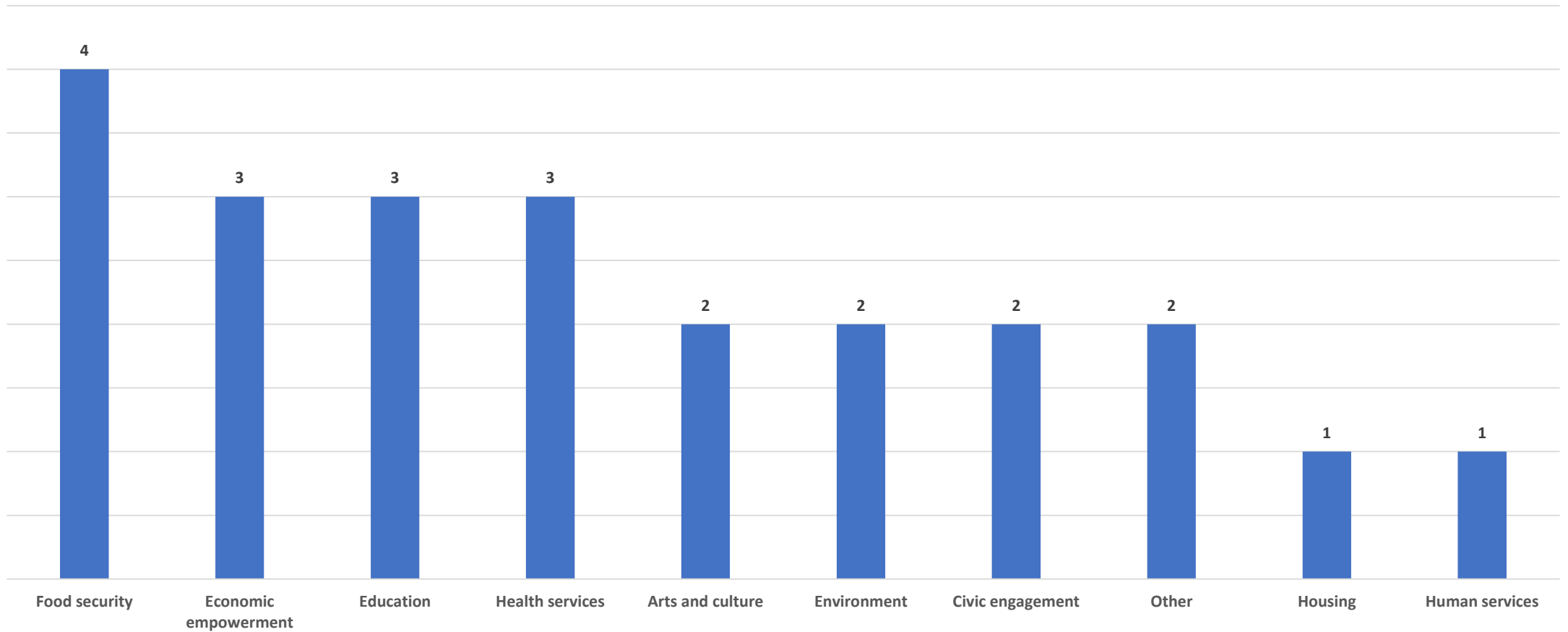


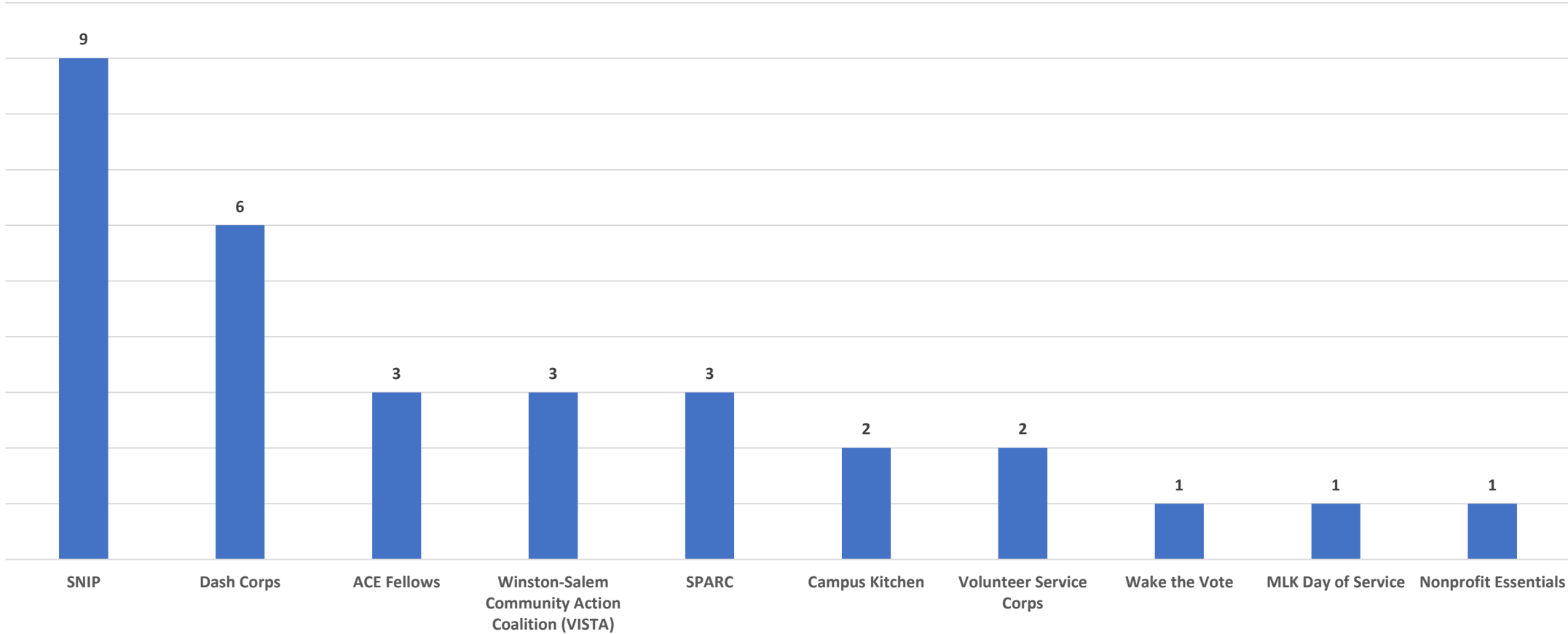
Two-thirds of partner respondents have worked with PHI for more than three years.



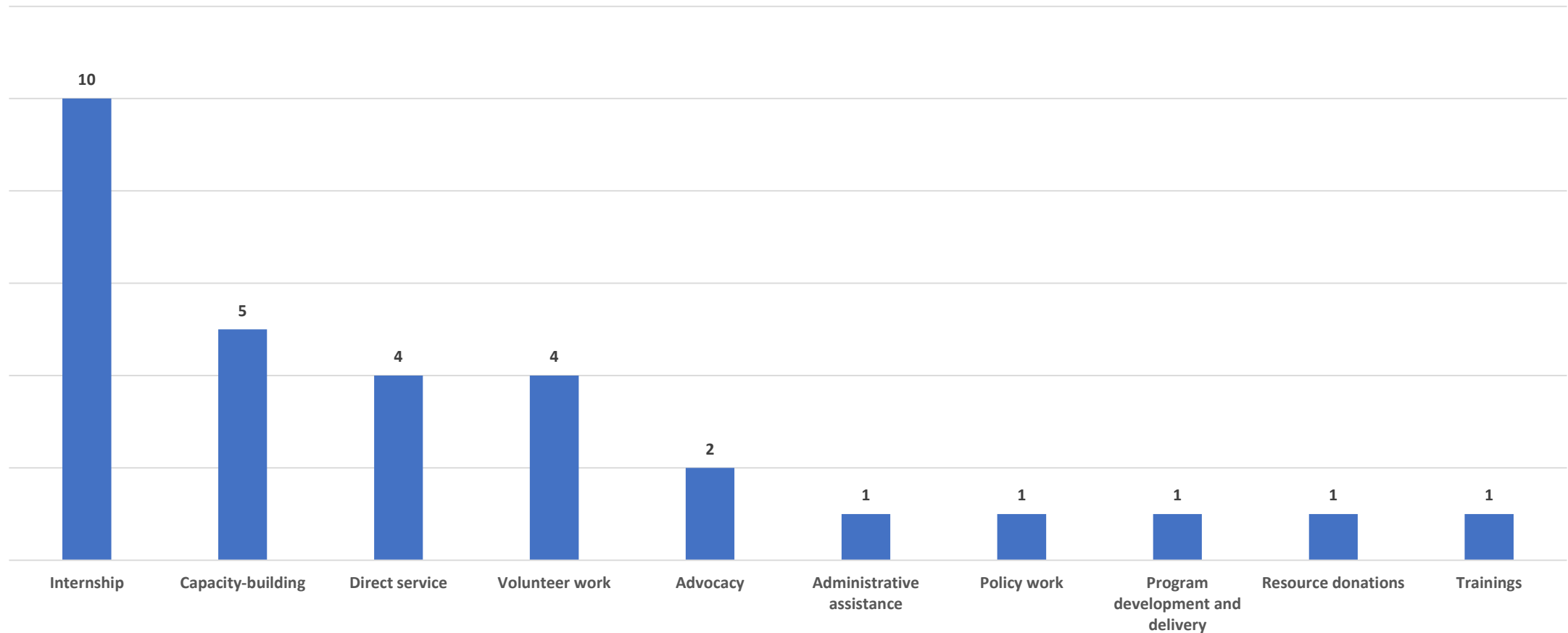
One-third of partners represented focus on food security.



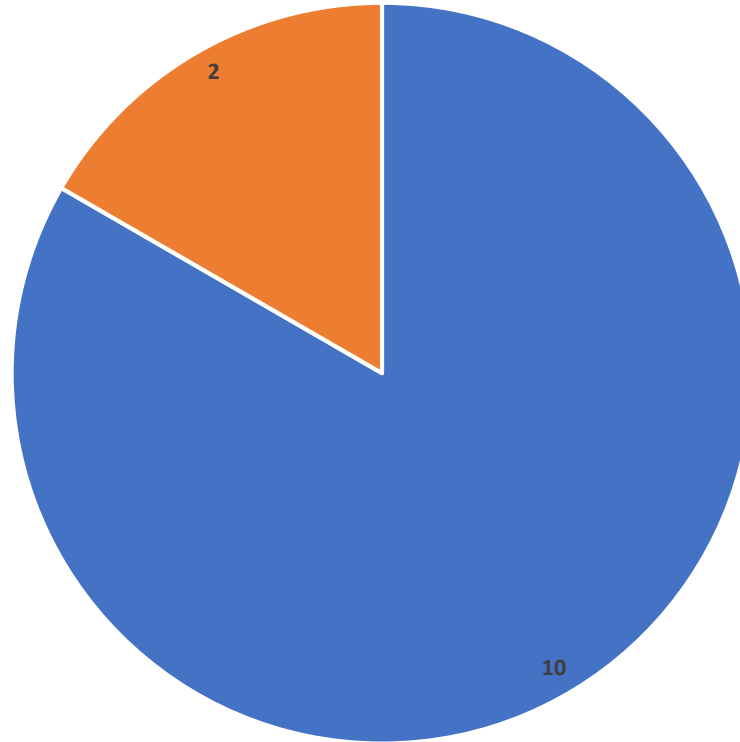
Two-thirds of responding partners have engaged with PHI through SNIP.



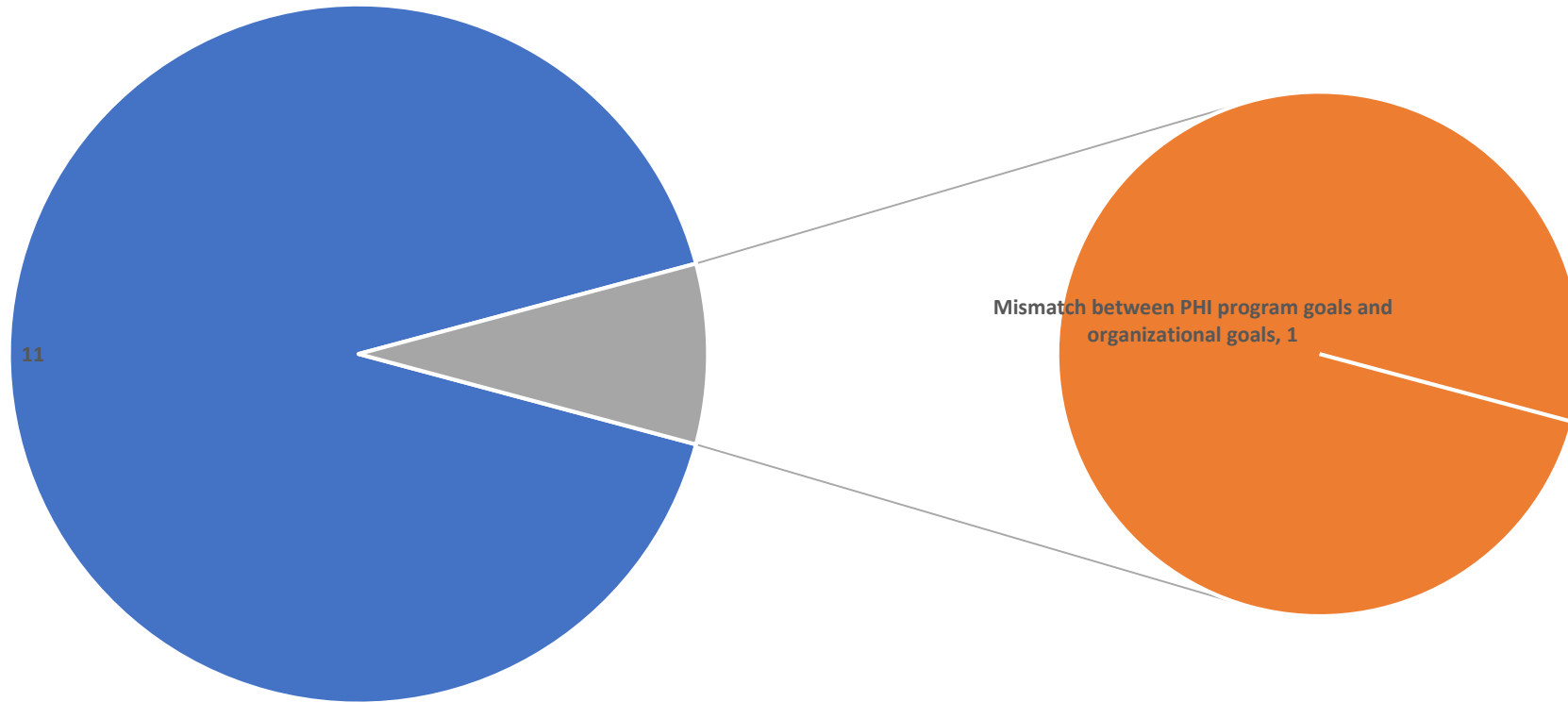
Four of five partner respondents typically engage with PHI through internships.



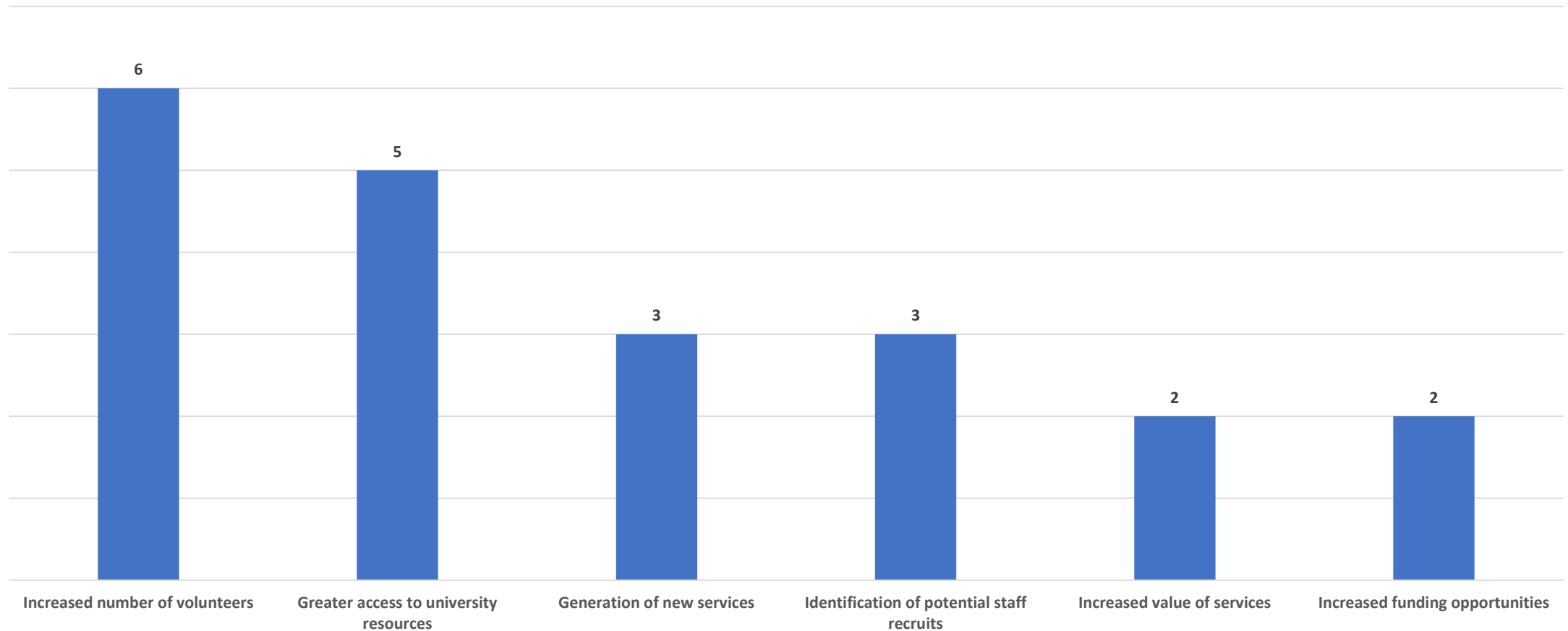
All respondents report **increased** or **maintained** capacity due to their organization's engagement with PHI.



More than 90 percent of respondents report **no challenges** associated with involvement with PHI programming.



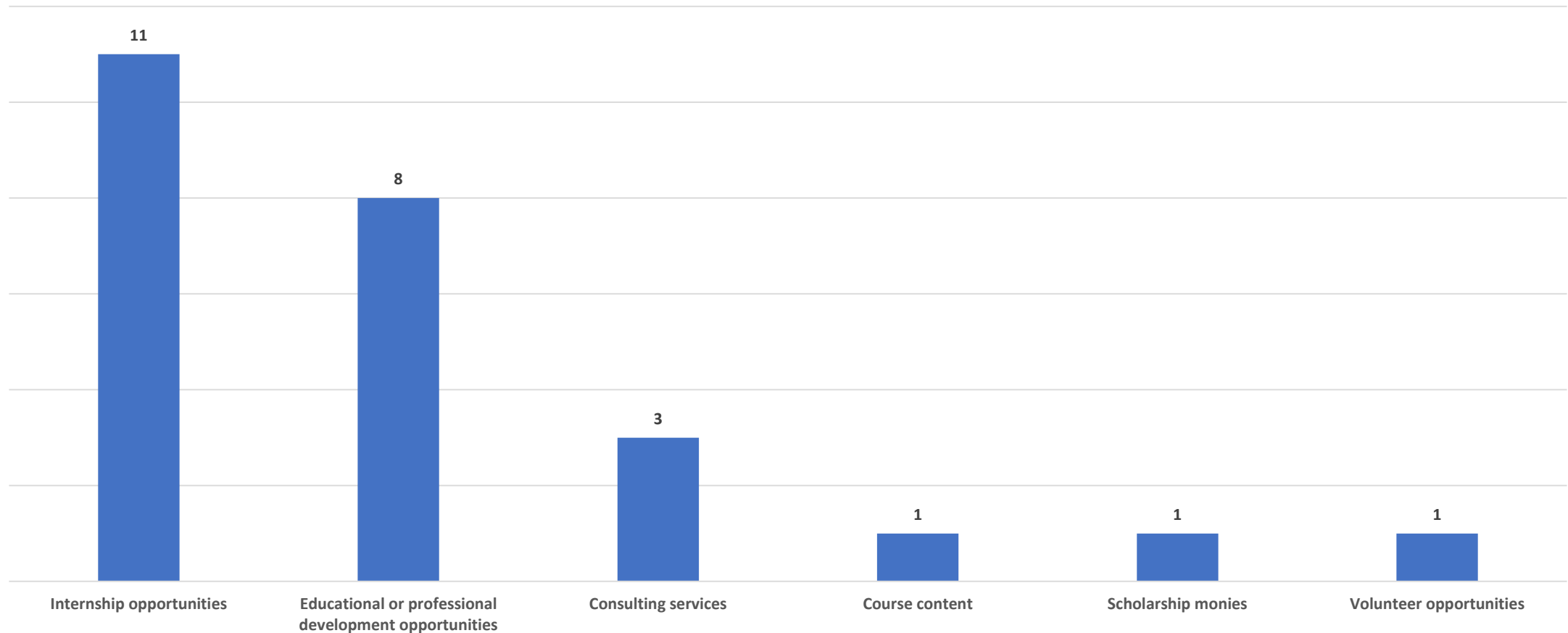
Engagement with PHI has enhanced the economic impact of partners in several ways.



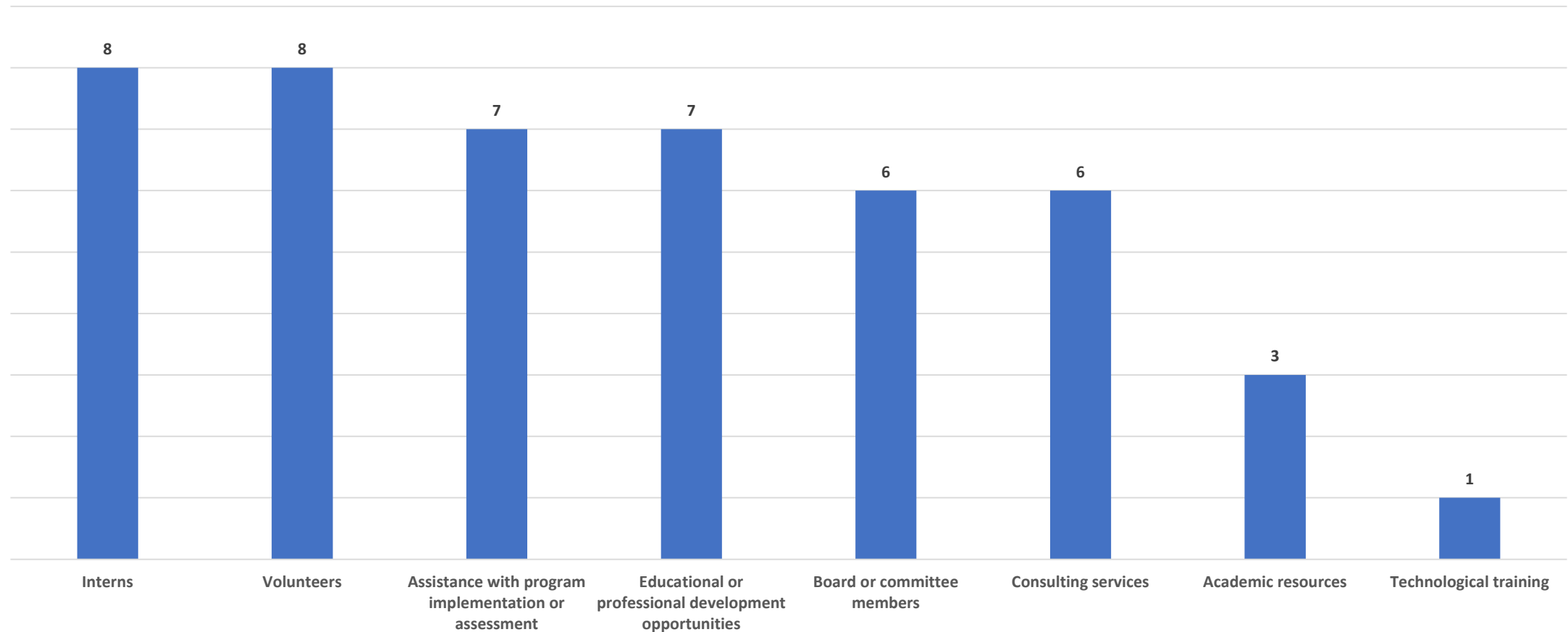
Partner respondents report a total of **\$200K** in economic impact, resulting from engagement with PHI.
