Senate Resolution 1

Relating to: Proposing an amendment of the Constitution of Student Government adding Angelou Residence Hall to first-year elections.

Fall 2017

Resolved by the Senate of the Wake Forest University Student Government here assembled, That the following be proposed as an amendment to Article III, Section 1(a)(7) of the Constitution of Student Government, which shall be valid to all intents and purposes of the Constitution when ratified by two-thirds of the Legislature:

“(7) Have each first-year student residence hall elect, from among its residents, one senator for every one hundred occupants of that unit. Upperclassmen shall elect one senator for every one hundred members per class. Where there are twenty-five or more additional students, an additional senator shall be chosen. Living units with fewer than fifty and at least twenty-five residents shall elect one senator. The first-year student residence halls are as follows: Angelou, Babcock, Bostwick, Collins, Johnson, Luter, and South.”
